Early Childhood

- **Book bag** (No wheels)- Large enough for notebook
- Pack of construction paper

- Girls-1 box quart size Ziploc bags, 6 LARGE glue sticks, baby wipes and/or wipe refills
- Boys-1 gallon size Ziploc bags, 1 NONWAXED pack of paper plates, dry erase markers
- Bottle of antibacterial soap or hand soap
- 1 Composition Book
- 1 container of Clorox/Lysol Disinfectant wipes
- ***These items must be labeled with your child's name. We have markers available at open house.**
- ***Please do not allow your child to bring pillows, toys, or stuffed animals from home. We prefer for students to wear Velcro shoes in place of shoes with laces.**
